Anti-Ragging Committee report: 2022-23

In the academic year 2022-23, the college started the academic session of UG program on 19th September, 2022 and celebrated the orientation program on the same day.

Under this committee, a program on Anti Ragging: Laws and awareness was arranged on that day in Satyajit Sabhakaksha of the college. The new-comer students were introduced to members of both the Anti-ragging committee and Anti-ragging Squad and they were introduced to the mandatory rules and regulations meant to prevent ragging through prospectus and brochure. The students were made aware of the mode of complaining to the concerned committee members if any such incident take place.

All the students enrolled in the college were divided into small groups and assigned a Mentor for any assistance or guidance. In addition, HODs of all the departments was directed to keep an close eye on the students to identify any act of ragging or aggressive behaviour that can harm others during his/her corse of study.

CCTV Cameras were installed at vital spots in the campus to keep a check on the activities of the students in the college premises. The monitor installed in the principal's office also helps to maintain a round-the-clock vigilance on any kind of unlawful activity by the students.

Biannual review meeting were conducted by Anti-ragging committee and follow up of students complaints were taken regularly to ensure that the fresher are able to pursue their studies without getting teased, insulted or in any way troubled by the seniors. Frequent rounds in the college and hostel campus were practiced by Anti-ragging squad to keep continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence.

Basirhat College campus is ragging-free; still all these measures have been taken to create a homely and friendly atmosphere for the first-semester students to pursue their studies. All of these were possible only because of the whole-hearted support from students and staffs. Owing to all these measures, no incident of ragging was reported in the college in the academic session 2022-23.
