## **Anti-Ragging Committee report: 2018-19**

The college started the academic session of UG program on 16.07.2018 and celebrated the orientation program on the same day.

The new-comer students were introduced to members of both the Anti-ragging committee and Anti-ragging Squad and they were made aware of indicating that ragging is strictly prohibited. All the new students were introduced to the mandatory rules and regulations meant to prevent ragging through prospectus and brochure. Flex boards were arranged and displayed that carry anti-ragging message and postures at various prominent places at the college campus. The names and phone numbers of the members of the Anti-ragging Cell were displayed prominently on hoardings installed at important spots in the college campus in addition to college website to enable students to approach them for help promptly.

All the students enrolled in the college were divided into small groups and assigned a Mentor for any assistance or guidance.

CCTV Cameras were installed at vital spots in the campus to keep a check on the activities of the students in the college premises. The monitor installed in the principal's office also helps to maintain a round-the-clock vigilance on any kind of unlawful activity by the students.

Tri-annual review meeting were conducted by Anti-ragging committee and follow up of students complaints were taken regularly to ensure that the fresher are able to pursue their studies without getting teased, insulted or in any way troubled by the seniors.

Owing to all these measures, no incident of ragging was reported in the college in the academic session 2018-19. Anti-Ragging cell was reconstituted on 26th March 2019 in presence of all members.

Dr. Ashoke Kumar Mondal, Chairman, Anti-ragging committee, welcomed the gathering. In absence of Prof. Dinabondhu Barat, convenor, Dr. Ayana Chakraborty, Teacher member of the committee, with his prior permission, conducted the meeting. The committee considered the agenda and the followings were resolved.

Agenda 1. The minutes and resolutions of the last meeting held on 17.04.2018 were read and confirmed.

Agenda 2. Resolved unanimously that, students of 1st semester to be introduced to the members of both Anti-ragging committee and Anti-ragging Squad in the ensuing orientation program, scheduled on 16.07.2018. It was further resolved that, posters and power point presentations be shown to them for communicating the message that ragging would strictly be handled.

Agenda 3. Resolved that, flex boards prepared and displayed to in multiple key points

Agenda 4. Resolved that, necessary actions be taken by the Anti-ragging Committee for wide publicity of the measures which the institution might take to curb the menace of ragging from time to time. Detailed consideration of the topic from all angles of vision was followed by another unanimous resolution that, HODs of all the departments be directed to keep a close eye on the students to identify any act of ragging or aggressive behaviour that could harm others during their course of study.

- Resolved that, seniors be instructed to ensure that no ragging could occur in the institution. It is their responsibility to bring it to notice of higher officials if any such act takes place.
- ii. Resolved that, authorities be requested to enhance vigilance to keep an eye on strangers-outsiders at the college campus, and entry of students be denied without student ID card.
- iii. Resolved that, all departmental Heads be requested to depute one teacher for a group of 8-10 fresh students for interaction with them. It was further resolved that, mentoring might be held in tutorial and other free hours apart from normal class routine, vide 6.2 [f, h, i]) clauses in the UGC regulations (www.ugc.ac.in).
