Anti-Ragging Committee Report 2020-21

The college started the academic session of UG program on 19th December, 2020 and celebrated the orientation program on 21st December, 2020.

Since, it was all in pandemic situation, the orientation program was online via Google meet. The new-comer students were introduced to both the Anti-ragging committee and Anti-ragging Squad and they were made aware of indicating that ragging is strictly prohibited. Two short films and a documentary film were shown to the students on ill effects of ragging.

Since all the classes were on online mode no complaints were raised during academic year 2020-2021. Still to avoid any act of abuse by spoken words, emails, SMS or public insult etc. committee conducted class on legal awareness for the students as online mode. General awareness on ragging was given by committee members to students. Circulation of 'SAY NO TO RAGGING' postures with details of ragging alert mail id were done through whatsapp groups. A group of five to ten students were allocated to each teacher of the college for interacting and mentoring purpose. They could easily be approached for any assistance or guidance through phone, Whatsapp or in the Google Classroom. In addition to that, they were made aware of that, our college has an active Student Grievance Redressal Cell which can also be easily approached in case of need. The names and phone numbers of the Committee were displayed prominently within the campus as well as the institutional website.

Biannual review meeting were conducted via Google meet by Anti-ragging committee and Anti-ragging squad. Anti-Ragging cell was reconstituted via Google meet on 3rd April 2021 in presence of all members.

Detailed consideration of the topic from all angles of vision was followed by another unanimous resolution that, HODs of all the departments be directed to keep a close eye on the students to identify any act of ragging or aggressive behaviour that could harm others during their course of study.

- ii. Resolved that, authorities be requested to enhance vigilance to keep an eye on strangers-outsiders at the college campus, and entry of students be denied without student ID card.
- iii. Resolved that, all departmental Heads be requested to depute one teacher for a group of 8-10 fresh students for interaction with them. It was further resolved that, mentoring might be held in tutorial and other free hours apart from normal class routine, vide 6.2 [f, h, i]) clauses in the UGC regulations (www.ugc.ac.in).
