# **Anti-Ragging Committee report: 2021-22**

Basirhat College appointed an Anti-Ragging committee to prevent the menace of ragging and maintain healthy interpersonal relations among students in the college campus. Ragging is strictly forbidden in or outside the college campus. For this Purpose the Anti-Ragging Committee has been actively functioning.

In the academic year 2021-22, the college started the academic session of UG program on October, 5th, 2021 and celebrated the orientation program on that day. During the program held in the online mode during the Covid-19 Pandemic, the Convener and members of the Anti-ragging Cell were introduced to the new students. All the new students were introduced to the mandatory rules and regulations meant to prevent ragging through prospectus and brochure. Flex boards were arranged and displayed that carry anti-ragging message and postures at various prominent places at the college campus. The names and phone numbers of the members of the Anti-ragging Cell were displayed prominently on hoardings installed at important spots in the college campus in addition to college website to enable students to approach them for help promptly.

Under this committee, a program on Anti Ragging: Laws and awareness was arranged on 08.02. 2022. Hon. Speaker Mr. Gopal Sarkar (Police Administration, Basirhat) expressed his views on anti-Ragging laws and punishments. In this program, legal officer member, Mr. Arindam Goldar also shared his views on anti-ragging.

Tri-annual review meeting were conducted by Anti-ragging committee and Anti-ragging squad to ensure that the fresher are able to pursue their studies without getting teased, insulted or in any way troubled by the seniors. Frequent rounds in the college and hostel campus were practiced by Anti-ragging squad to keep continuous watch and vigil over ragging so as to prevent its occurrence and recurrence. The residential wardens of boys' hostel monitored the students regularly in the mess during the breakfast, lunch, and dinner time there by ensuring the comfort zone for the new-comer students in the hostel mess.

Basirhat College campus is ragging-free; still all these measures have been taken to create a homely and friendly atmosphere for the first-semester students to pursue their studies. All of these were possible only because of the whole-hearted support from students and staffs. Hence no ragging is reported in the campus in the academic year 2021-22.

Detailed consideration of the topic from all angles of vision was followed by another unanimous resolution that, HODs of all the departments be directed to keep a close eye on the students to identify any act of ragging or aggressive behaviour that could harm others during their course of study.

Agenda 5. Resolved that, to prevent ragging, information about measures and actions taken against ragging by the institutions, information about e-mail id for complaint lodging, Toll-free anti-ragging helpline number are to be incorporated in brochure and shared to the students.

#### Agenda 6. Miscellaneous

- Resolved that, seniors be instructed to ensure that no ragging could occur in the institution. It is their responsibility to bring it to notice of higher officials if any such act takes place.
- Resolved that, authorities be requested to enhance vigilance to keep an eye on strangers-outsiders at the college campus, and entry of students be denied without student ID card.
