SEM-I

Course Name: Pragadhunik Bangla Sahityer Itihas Course Code: BNGACOR01T

- CO1 The Charyapada is a collection of Buddhist mystic songs. 'Shrikrishnakirtan'- lyric was love affair between Radha and Krishna. 'Mangal kavya' Bangla Anubad Sahitya, Bangla Padabali sahitya are a group of Bengali religious texts or Hindu and Islamic scripts.
- CO2 Many poems in Charyapada, Srikrishnakirtan, Mangal Kabya, Anubad Sahitya etc. provide realistic pictures of early medieval society in eastern India.
- CO3 Charcha pada is the first script in Bengali language. Shrikrishnakirtan is a second script in Bengali language.
- CO4 Charyapada, Shrikrishnakirtan, Mangalkabya composed more or less between 8th and 18th centuries.
- CO5 Translated literature Maladhar Basu composed ShriKrishna Vijay, a free translation of Sanskrit Vagbat Puran. Magal kabya described the greatness of a particular deity, usually one indigenous to Bengal.
- **CO6** This course will also help in understanding the foundation of grammar stronger.
