GEOGRAPHY HONOURS

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PO1	Disciplinary knowledge: An under-graduate student of geography will be able to acquire detailed and comprehensive knowledge in the discipline. This will help them to correlate geography with other disciplines in a holistic manner. The disciplinary knowledge will make them accommodative.
PO2	Communication skills: The disciplinary knowledge will grow multi-dimensional skills in the students which will help them to connect with people / society through verbal or writing mode. They will be able to convey their views to the society on one hand and will develop a clear understanding about the needs and demands of the society.
PO3	Critical thinking: The students of geography will develop critical thinking which help them to analyze and evaluate evidence, arguments, claims, beliefs on the basis of empirical evidence; identify relevant assumptions or implications; formulate coherent arguments; critically evaluate practices, policies.
PO4	Problem solving: The offered programme of geography will help the student to gather some problem solving techniques. These techniques will help them to understand the problem of their surrounding physical and socio-economic environment in an integrated manner and will able to solve them.
PO5	Analytical reasoning: Through the practice of the offered programme in geography the students will gather the analytical reasoning capacity. The student will able to evaluate the reliability and relevance of evidence; identify logical flaws and holes in the arguments of others; analyze and synthesize data from a variety of sources and support them with evidence and examples, and addressing opposing viewpoints
PO6	Research-related skills: The student will be familiar with research work through the offered programme in Geography. This will help the student to think different physical as well as social oriented problems in a scientific manner and able to find out the proper mitigation/mitigations.
PO7	Cooperation/Team work: The programme in geography offers a field work which helps them to work in a group and through this they will learn cooperation, empathy and mutual respect.
PO8	Scientific reasoning: The programme in geography will help the students to be able to analyze, interpret and draw conclusions from quantitative/qualitative data; and critically evaluate ideas, evidences and experiences from an open-minded and reasoned perspective.
